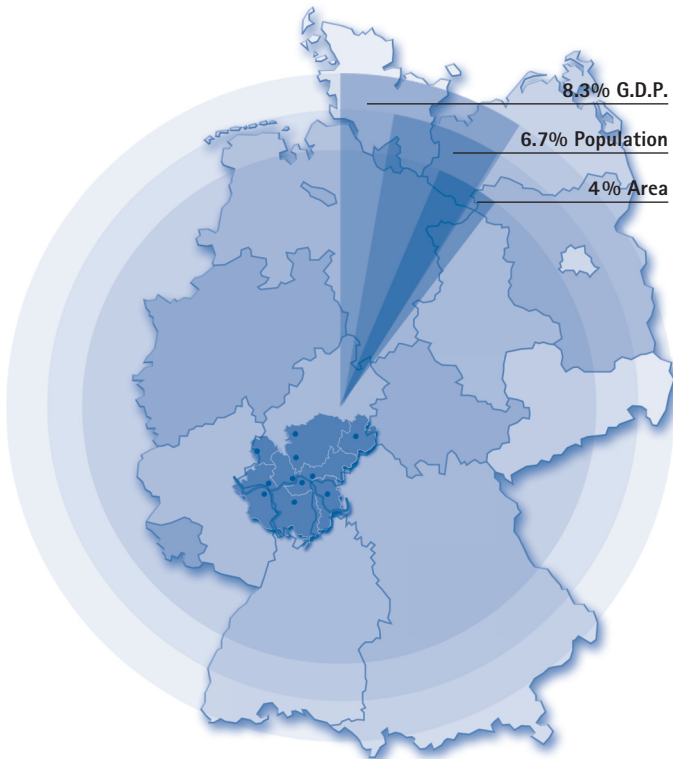

Transport Infrastructure FrankfurtRheinMain

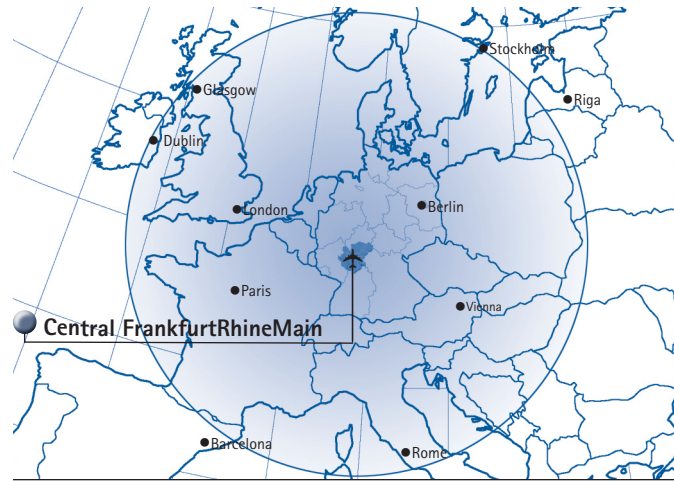
